- 4. Agenda Approval:
  - Motion made and seconded (Berkowitz/Parker) to accept the agenda as submitted; passed 4-0
- 5. Cross-Connection Control Plan
  - a) Fred Handy, FRWA to answer any questions concerning CCCP Fred Handy, FRWA, explained that the CCCP is required by the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and answered questions. The DEP provided a template to the Town Administrator which she completed and the DEP approved. The CCCP will protect the Town employees if cross contamination occurs. Commissioner Parker questioned the need to have a back flow preventer if your hot water heater is not up to code (must have a pressure relief valve on a hot water heater), and he was reassured that this is required when obtaining a building permit. Mrs. Gonano stated that a survey will be provided to all water customers to gain knowledge of any potential cross-connection problems.

- 6. Resolution 2016-13 Storm Water Resolution Mayor Mance presented

This Resolution is in opposition to the proposed Alachua County Stormwater Manual and schedule for adoption without meaningful review and comment by the municipalities. The County's plan requires an extremely expensive product known as BAM, which will need replacement every 10 years. Alachua County is trying to discredit the Alachua County League of Cities, whose purpose is to unite the County's municipalities.
